### Purpose:

In today's culture & society, people are expected to THINK a certain way when it comes to "MORALS" & "VALUES". It truly is a culture that says: "YOU DO YOU". When it comes to truth, there is no "absolute truth", it seems to change all the time.

However, just because people are expected to THINK a certain way in this culture, doesn't mean we as Christians need to conform to the culture or its standards. In fact, we are told to do the opposite in Romans 12. Instead of allowing the culture to govern how we THINK, we are asked to present our "bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God". In doing so, this is our "reasonable service", or "true worship".

For a Christian... as we truly worship the Lord, by giving our bodies to Him... the Spirit of God transforms our life by renewing our mind. Thus, we as Christians TINK DIFFREN, then the culture, because the Spirit is changing our minds and our lives.

We pray that all who attend, would learn to TINK DIFFREN, as we see, know and understand that JESUS needs to be the center of our life.

## What is Needed Before the Retreat from your church:

### 1. Prayer

2. **Church Deposit of \$200** (due before Dec 1<sup>st</sup> . This deposit will be subtracted from your final balance)

### 3. Funds Collected

-Cost of Retreat is \$140 per person (1<sup>st</sup> Deposit of \$75 due Dec 1<sup>st</sup>-8th , 2<sup>nd</sup> Deposit of \$62 due Jan 5<sup>th</sup>-12th )

### 4. Certificate of General Liability:

-Call your church insurance company for this & fax it to the Retreat Center.(909-867-4777)

### 5. Shirt Sizes must be turned in by 1<sup>st</sup> Weekend of January

-Shirts will be ordered in MENS SIZES only. Shirts run "a little small".

### 6. Team Break-Up:

-Please split your group into 4 equal teams (including all leaders) if your church has 15 or more attending. If less than 15, please split your Group into 2 equal teams.

-This year's colors are **GREEN, BLUE, RED and YELLOW**. Please encourage your youth to bring (or your church can buy it for them), bandanas, beanie's, &/or shirts of the team color, to be worn throughout the Retreat.

### 7. Arrive @ Retreat on Time:

- make best possible arrangements to be at the camp at 7pm (dinner will be served @ this time.) 1st Session will begin promptly @ 8pm

## What is Needed Once Youth Group Arrive at the Retreat:

1. Once you arrive we ask you to park your vehicles in front of the office or "TOP PARKING LOT", and send a Leader(s) to the CAMP OFFICE. At the **CAMP OFFICE**, you will receive your Cabin Assignments, Shirt Order, Retreat Giveaways & Team Lanyard

2. At the office, please turn in: **MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS**(place all forms in one folder with Church Name on it), **FINAL COUNT** of your Group, & **FINAL BALANCE**

**-IF YOU ARRIVE BEFORE 7pm:** Check in @ office to find where your cabin is, and then unload at the cabins & promptly have your group meet at the Dining Hall @ 7pm

**-IF YOU ARRIVE between 7pm-730pm:** Check in @ the office, bring your group to the dining hall to eat. Then Unload after Service

**-IF YOU ARRIVE AFTER 745pm:** Eat before you ARRIVE!!!

-Head straight to Sanctuary for 1<sup>st</sup> Session

-After 1<sup>st</sup> Session, please send Leader(s) to the **BACK** of the Sanctuary to check in

## RETREAT ABSOLUES:

The following ABSOLUTES are cause for immediate removal from the camp. In extreme cases we may call local law enforcement as well:

- No DRUGS
- NO ALCOHOL
- NO VULGAR LANGUAGE
- NO FIRE of any KIND
- NO WEAPONS of any KIND
- NO PUBLIC DISPLAY of AFFECTION(NBC RULE)
- NO GUYS in the GIRLS DORM or GIRLS in the GUYS DORM

- NO STEALING
- NO DESTRUCTION of CAMP PROPERTY

## COMMUNICATION:

The Retreat ask that you make a phone list in which parents can call youth leader & that the Retreat would be the last option for parents to call, in order to contact their children.

## Medication & Food:

If any child needs a special diet, please let us know before the retreat, so we can make arrangements with the Retreat Center

Also we will be providing a Nurse and EMT for the Retreat. They will have a few supplies with them, that should help stabilize anyone, if any injury occurs, until the Ambulance can arrive to the Retreat.

They will also be carrying a few over the counter medicines with them to help with any headaches and nausea. If any of your Youth have a problem and need medicine, they will need to come with their youth leader to receive any over the counter medication. Please insure that they are not allergic with the medicine. (have a list of any over the counter medicine your youth may be allergic too)

## Your Role as a LEADER Before that Retreat:

**1. Pray:** Please pray daily for your youth & those who will attend

- For their walk w/ the Lord, for faithfulness to home & school, finances

-For them to INVITE people to JESUS, BELIEVE in JESUS, & a heart to SERVE JESUS through the HOLY SPIRIT

**2. Invite & Inform:** Please contact & talk to youth as well as parents

- Be challenged to not only inform your Youth Group, but take an active role personally, to let the Parents know what is going on.

**3. Serve:** Get involved in the Youth's lives so that they would desire to spend a weekend w/ Jesus & you

- See ways in which you can pour into these youths so that they can BELIEVE in JESUS through your life. We need to exemplify & live out this theme of ABIDE IN before the Retreat starts!

-Also, prepare to drive a car in the snow (whether that means yours or someone else's, make arrangements to be prepared to drive)

## Your Role as a LEADER During the Retreat

**1. Pray:** Please be in constant prayer during the Retreat

**2. SHEPHARD:** Be watchful over all the youth... not as a hireling... but a shepherd who loves the sheep

- Keep an eye on your youth, and make sure their "environment" at the Retreat is one that isn't distracting to what God wants to do and speak to them.

-Be watchful for all the Youth that attend, not just your own.

**3. LEAD BY EXAMPLE:** specifically during GAMES & TEACHINGS. For the most part, Youth will only get excited or involved in things, as much as their leaders will. So please participate and interact, not just for the sake of interaction, but to encourage & lead through your actions, the Youth that you bring.
